


## Accessing the DoE Student Portal

All students in NSW Government schools have free access to the Student Portal. It contains an email account, access to Oliver (the school library system), links to educational websites and free online access to software such as Microsoft 365 and Google Suite.

Once enrolled, students are automatically generated a unique user ID. This is usually in the form of firstname.surname, eg john.smith. When there is a repeat of a name, a number is added, eg John.smith33.

This also forms the basis for the email address, eg john.smith@education.nsw.gov.au

Students are then given a password which they can change after they have logged in. See below for a guide to logging in. <https://morisset-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/>


