Selective High School Applications 2015

Please note that if you wish to apply for a Selective High School in 2015 an "Intention to Apply—Year 7 entry into selective high schools in 2015" form should be filled out **as soon as possible**. These forms are available from the school office.

After these are received by the school, it will be necessary to apply, either:

on-line at -www.schools.nsw.edu.au/shsplcement

OR.

if the internet is not available, fill out a form supplied by the school, which will be available from 22nd October 2013. Both forms of application will need to be completed by 18th November 2013. In the case of the paper application, it will need to be returned to school by 18th November 2013.

School Attendance!

Did you know?

That if your child misses 8 days in a school term, by the end of primary school they will have missed a year of education.

Once your child is enrolled in school they are required to attend school every day that instruction is provided.

All absences must be justified by either sending in a note to the class teacher or ringing the school on the day of absence.

Principals may request a doctor's certificate for prolonged illnesses.

Exemptions from absence may be granted by the principal for ongoing medical or speech appointments and long term infectious illnesses.

Exemptions from absence may be granted by the principal for family vacations.

Exemption forms are available at the school office and must be filled in prior to absence. They cannot be back dated.

Parents may be prosecuted if children of compulsory school age (6years – 17 years) have recurring numbers of unjustified absences.






MINGARA

Who may play:

From Kindy kids to 17-year-olds (no minimum age).

Minimum ability:

Beginners are very welcome, but must know the basic rules of the game and how the pieces move. Must be able to complete a game unassisted.

Prizes:

About half of all players will win prizes, which are awarded over a number of age groups. This is a non-profit tournament with all entry fees after minimal expenses to be returned as prizes.

Format: 7-round Swiss

Time control: 15 mins per player (longer in later rounds if time permits).

All entrants will play seven games.

Puzzle solving competitions:

Prizes for solving chess puzzles after each round.

\$10 - can help offer free exercise programs to help cancer patients build strength and fitness during and after treatment.


\$25- can help transport cancer patients to and from hospital for treatment.


