National Day of Mourning Public Holiday Thursday September 22

Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II passed away late last week after over 70 years as Queen and Australia's head of state. As part of the commemoration of her life, a public holiday has been declared for the National Day of Mourning. This means that classes scheduled for Thursday 22 September will not take place.

Change to COVID-19 isolation requirement from Friday September 9

On Thursday August 31, National Cabinet agreed to reduce the isolation period for COVID-19 positive cases to 5 days, with the following caveats:

- · this would apply only to people with no symptoms at day 5 of their isolation In mainstream school settings, all staff, students and visitors who have tested positive to COVID-19 must:
- complete 5 days of isolation from the date they tested positive
- be symptom-free before returning to school, if symptoms remain after Day 5 they must continue following NSW Health guidelines to self-isolate and undertake a rapid antigen test and,
- \cdot complete a rapid antigen test (RAT) and return a negative result before attending school on Days 6 and 7 after testing positive to COVID-19. For more information https://education.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/advice-for-families

We are excited to announce the Lake Macquarie City Council's new program, **Confident Kids**, which is supported by funding from the Regional NSW Child and Young People Wellbeing and Resilience Grant. Part of this program will focus on school holiday programs for children between the ages of 5 and 9, aiming to provide children (and their families) with opportunities to develop connections with their community, build resilience, and expand self-confidence.

Our first three school holiday programs have been planned and I would love for you to share them with your community!

We have partnered with **Swansea SES** for our first few events. They will be creating an obstacle course designed to teach children about water safety while providing opportunity for personal growth. 
