You too could become part of the great team of volunteers who help out in our canteen - get to see your children/grandchildren at school, meet new friends and have a great time! See over for more details on how to join us.



- 4. Login, click **STUDENT** then **ADD NEW STUDENT** to set up your children under their relevant
- 5. You are now ready to order!

ORDERING AT THE CANTEEN:

CASH OPTION

 Send cash in with your child on the day, either with a pre-written lunch bag, or they can write their own (bags cost 10c at canteen)

********NO EFTPOS AT THE CANTEEN*******

ONLINE (SCHOOL 24) OPTION

- Cut off times for online canteen orders is 9am each Wednesday and Friday
- Ensure the order has been submitted in full and you receive a confirmation. You can check via order history
- If you have created an order ahead of time & your child is absent you can cancel the order online up until the 9am deadline on the day
- Any frozen items can ONLY be ordered in conjunction with lunch items
- No orders for Friday recess so please do NOT include in online orders
- To order a regular favourite, you can simply click on order history, click re-order and then select the date
- BIRTHDAY MUFFINS these must be ordered at least a week prior to the day they are required as it takes time to ensure we have enough available. Please email us at mpspc@yahoo.com after placing your order, especially if you place the order during the holidays.

BIRTHDAY MUFFINS ORDER FORM

Fruit muffins for birthday children are made to order in the canteen.

They are available in 3 flavours: Apple cinnamon, Banana or Blueberry.

The cost is per muffin, as numbers will depend on how many children are in your child's class.

Orders must be placed at least a week in advance to allow us time to prepare the muffins for your child – they will then be delivered directly from the canteen to the classroom.

These muffins comply with the Healthy School Canteen's guidelines.

Ingredients: self-raising flour (GF if required), Fairy margarine, brown sugar, egg, honey, bicarb (banana only), milk (apple/cinnamon and blueberry), vanilla essence (banana only). Banana, green apples, cinnamon and blueberries in appropriately named muffins.

Gluten free options are available on request.

Uniform Shop Opening Hours:

Uniform Shop is open on Fridays from 12:30 – 1:30pm for customers and for packing orders.

Online orders must be placed by 5pm on the Thursday before to receive the items on the Friday.

If uniform is needed urgently, please call or see the Office staff for help.

MORISSET P&C UNIFORM ORDERING

ORDERING/PAYMENT OPTIONS

CASH - Order forms (see next page) can be obtained from the school office, downloaded from the school website or the P&C FB page. Please fill in all details as shown and return to the office with full cash payment. Items will not be released to you without full payment.

BANK TRANSFER - As above, fill in a paper form and return it to the office. Our uniform shop bank details are shown on the form OR you can use **PayID** using our email address – please retain the receipt number when you pay by bank transfer as you will need to show this in order to receive your items.

EFTPOS – We can now take payment by EFTPOS but only when a P&C member is on site as the school staff do not have access to our Square reader.

ONLINE (SCHOOL24) – Once you have created your School24 account you can use it to buy uniform.

Cut off time for online School24 orders each week is Thursday 5pm for collection the next day Pick up will be from the office – your order will be packed ready for you to collect after 1.30pm on the Friday. If payment is completed, your child can collect your order.

NSW Back To School Vouchers – You can pay for uniforms using these vouchers but only in person, or by emailing us at mpspc@yahoo.com with voucher codes. School24 cannot accept these vouchers but you can still order online as follows:

- 1) Send us an email, putting "Back to School Vouchers PARENT account name" in the subject line- in the body of the email, please include the Voucher numbers and the child's name that you are ordering for (the name on the voucher doesn't have to match the child you are ordering for, if you have more than one eligible child)
- 2) Create your online order and at checkout, select "Payment at Pick Up".

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO CHANGE CAN BE GIVEN FOR THE VOUCHERS — if your order comes to e.g. \$125, you can use 2 vouchers and pay the rest by a different method, or use 3 vouchers and waste \$25 of them.

If you need **to view or try on the uniform** items, please contact the office to arrange a suitable time to come in to the Uniform shop, or come in when **we are open from 12:30 to 1:30pm on Fridays.**
