2020 ANNUAL SWIMMING CARNIVAL

Our annual swimming carnival will be held on <u>Monday February 3 2020</u> at the Morisset Pool. Compulsory attendance is required for all students in Years 3-6. Students in Year 2, who are confident swimmers and turn 8 this year may also participate in the carnival.

TIME: Students are required to come to school before the carnival so class rolls can be marked. Students will leave school at 9.00am and the carnival should start by 9.30am with an expected finish no later than 2.45pm.

WHAT TO BRING: Students are encouraged to wear colours that support their house. MACQUARIE=BLUE; PULBAH=GREEN; WATAGAN=YELLOW. Additional to this, don't forget swimmers, a towel, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks and a water bottle. The school's sun safe policy advises students to wear a sun safe rash shirt.

LUNCH: Students can take a packed lunch or purchase from a selected menu at the pool.

COST: The cost is **\$3.50 per student**. This payment needs to be made at school as soon as possible.

SPECTATORS: The school encourages and welcomes parents to attend the carnival to help support all our students. If any spectator wishes to attend the carnival, the pool will charge a fee per person. All siblings that come, are the responsibility of their carer/parent. The pool enforces a policy whereby everyone must leave the grounds at the conclusion of the carnival and then pay the usual pool fee to re-enter.

PLEASE NOTE: To ensure the smooth running of scheduled events during the day, ALL students are to remain in their house area when not participating in events. If you come to the pool to support your child, please see them or sit with them in their designated area. This expectation will be enforced on the day so that supervision is not compromised and students do not miss out on participating in their events.
