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## School Swimming Scheme

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Morisset Public School has been allocated national funding for the School Swimming Scheme in 2020 and as a result you will only have to pay \$35 instead of \$60.

The School Swimming Scheme will take place at Morisset pool under the instruction of qualified teachers. The scheme will run daily for one week from Monday the February 24 until Friday the March 6. Sessions will start at approximately 11.30am and finish at 12:30pm. The program consists of ten, 1 hour sessions over the course of only two week. Students are expected to attend every day.

Students who are eligible to take part are those who have difficulty swimming 25m in deep water using correct technique. **If students have previously been involved in the scheme last year, they can still take part again this year.** The total cost for the 5 lessons and pool entry will be \$35.

Students will be walking to and from the pool for their lessons under the supervision of teachers. We will be leaving school at 11:15am and returning around 2pm. During times of wet weather we may need to catch a bus to/from Morisset pool.

Each child should bring a swimming costume, a towel, a shirt, a hat and warm clothing on a cool day. Students must have a pair of goggles and girls will need to have their hair tied back or wear a swimming cap. As the children will be swimming in an outdoor pool, we ask that students use adequate sun protection, eg an SPF 30+ broad spectrum, water resistant sun screen that is applied regularly. A T-Shirt or rash shirt is also recommended. On Friday (only), students will need to have old clothes on that they can wear into the water. This is a safety component of the program.

If you wish your child to be involved in this program, please complete the section below and return it along with \$35 to the school by Tuesday, February 18, 2020. Alternatively payment may be made online on the school website. You will need to record the receipt number on the permission note below. Places are limited, so those first to pay in full will receive priority. **PLEASE NOTE IF YOU PAY ON LINE, PERMISSION NOTE NEEDS TO BE RETURNED IMMEDIATELY.**
