### Suggested Information:

- Athlete's full name
- What sport do they play?
- Are they part of a team?
- Background information when/where were they born? How old are they now? What country are they from? Are they a Paralympian?
- When did they start playing their sport?
- How did they go at the 2021 Olympics?
- Have they been to the Olympics before?
- What has been their greatest achievement?
- Photos of their athlete
- Interesting facts
- What 'You Can Do It' keys (organisation, resilience, persistence, getting along, confidence) did the athlete need to use?

#### <u>Remember to:</u>

- Consider how you will present your information (eg. PowerPoint presentation, movie, photos, poster, etc).
- Look at the audience
- Stand up straight
- Speak clearly
- Present your information logically
- Use suitable language (appropriate for your audience)
- Make sure you include a conclusion
- Refer to your visual aid during your presentation
- Practice before several times in front of a mirror or in front of a member of your family (time yourself)
